Site closure

The main site remains closed to all visitors except those involved in the delivery of core educational programmes. This includes students, teaching, admin and site staff.

Managing symptoms

Please do not attend if you are showing any signs of Covid-19. This includes:

- a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back
- a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

If you are showing symptoms you are required to self-isolate.

Infrared thermometer

We reserve the right to test any visitor's temperature before they come on site.

Face masks

All visitors must wear a face mask when accessing any inside spaces. This includes classrooms, corridors and the Green House. Exemptions are made for those on medical or SEN grounds. Masks are not required outside.

Social distancing

Staying at least 1m (preferably 2m) apart if vital to reduce the risk of transmission.

Face masks

Personal hygiene

All visitors are expected to manage a good level of personal hygiene which includes hand washing at regular intervals during the day.

Testing for Covid

You can have a test (swab test) to check if you have Covid-19. You can choose to be tested:

- At a test site near you today and get your result tomorrow
- With a home test kit

You can get a test:

- For yourself, if you have Covid-19 symptoms
- For someone you live with, if they have symptoms

We can support you with getting a test if needed.
