The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is a regulation in EU law on data protection and privacy for all individuals within the European Union. It addresses the export of personal data outside the EU and will be in effect from 25th May 2017,



Roots and Shoots are taking the appropriate steps in complying to the GDPR laws before the deadline 25th May 2018.



Stay connected with Roots and Shoots. We **require your consent** to hold your name, address and email provided by you voluntarily and to be advised that you are happy to receive Roots and Shoots information and news.

GDPR gives everyone much more control over their personal data and it is Roots and Shoots responsibility to handle this information properly, including how it is used.

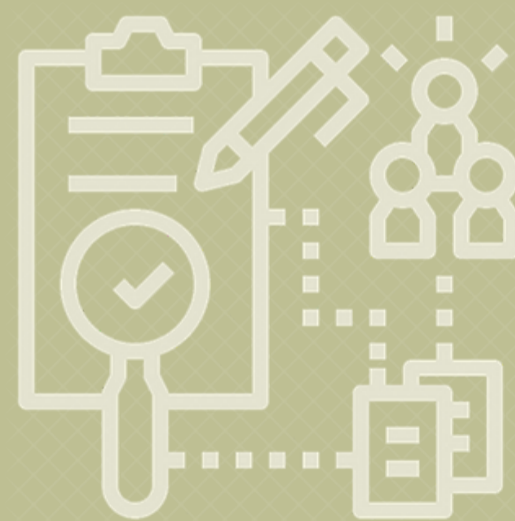


We will also take much better care of the information we hold on people and it is only ever used within Roots and Shoots and for Roots and Shoots funding purposes.
