LEARNING?	Building upon last year's audit, learning is bespoke and tailored to the needs of each individual child. Students are measured via the City and Guilds certification and they are also observed closely for the first 6 months of their arrival in order to observe their needs and any changes closely during this period. Students also have targets in terms of soft outcomes such as friendship skills.  There are termly reports and feedback with the local authority including SEND, CSC etc.
WHAT ARE THE	ASSESSMENT GRADING: RED AMBER GREEN
CURRENT KEY ISSUES AND PRIORITIES?	Staff are constantly reviewing student attainment and progress in order to stop them from stagnating (due to students remaining there for 3 years).
